Top Tips After a Bite

 Address medical needs immediately. Gently clean the bite with soap and water. Apply bandage or clean towel to stop any bleeding. Seek medical attention to prevent infection or other complications.



• Take photographs to document the bite.



• If possible, exchange information with the dog's owner to easily contact them later.



• If there are witnesses, obtain their contact information. This is helpful if you need to file an insurance claim.



• File a report with local animal control or other authorities to document history for the dog.
